# Taking your baby home & postnatal care COVID-19 (Coronavirus)



## Maternity Services would like to congratulate you on the birth of your new baby.

Women who are going home from birth suite or the postnatal ward will be offered access to postnatal midwife visits. If you are taking your baby home from the Special Care Nursery, you can expect a visit from either a midwife or special care nursery staff member, depending on your baby's needs. We will discuss these visits and plan them with you before you go home from hospital.

On the morning of your planned home visit you should expect a call from the hospital midwife who conduct a COVID-19 screening assessment. This will involve some questions about your health and your contact with suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19. Please note this will be from a **No Caller ID** number and we ask that you answer it.

If you begin to have flu like symptoms such as a fever with a sore throat or cough or have been in contact with someone with the above mentioned symptoms or a person who has a confirmed case of COVID-19, please call the appropriate number below so that we can plan your care.
