

Intern Pharmacist Rotations*

During Week 1 -33 of the intern program Intern Pharmacists will rotate through the following areas for the set period.

Rotation	Time
Clinical orientation	8 weeks (2 x separate 4 week blocks)
Non-clinical orientation (Medicines Information, Medication Safety, Antimicrobial Stewardship, Therapeutic Drug Monitoring, Oncology & Radiopharmacy)	2 weeks
Outpatients - dispensary and extemporaneous manufacturing	4 weeks (2 x separate 2 week blocks)
Sterile Manufacturing	1 week
General Medicine ward	3 weeks
Surgical ward	3 weeks
Cardiology ward	3 weeks
Renal/Gastroenterology ward	3 weeks
Neurology/Stroke ward	3 weeks
McKellar Centre - Rehabilitation/Palliative Care	2 weeks
Research	1 week

Beyond the first 33 weeks Intern Pharmacists;

- Will be integrated into pharmacy services with their own patient load and responsibilities.
- Complete elective rotations (e.g. paediatrics, emergency, psychiatry, oncology, ICU, maternity).

In total, Intern Pharmacists will spend approximately 80% of their intern program on clinical wards.
