

RESEARCH WEEK POSTER GUIDELINES 2018



POSTER PREPARATION

The content of your poster should be clear and understandable without requiring an oral explanation. The format should include an introduction, aim/s (in plain language), methods (brief), results (in graph or table format), and conclusion/s. Your poster should also include sample size.

Note: All research MUST be completed, with results, in order to be eligible for the Poster Competition. Your poster must be 1.0 – 1.2m (wide) by 1.0 - 1.2m (tall).

DISPLAY

Posters are required to be removed from the St Mary's Building by 3pm on Friday the 16th of November.
